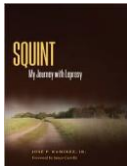
## James L. Krahenbuhl, Ph.D.

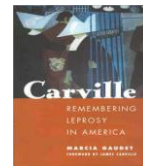
## *Squint: My Journey with Leprosy*

Discussion & Signing · Thursday, July 15<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 pm

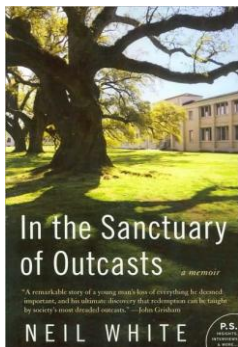
